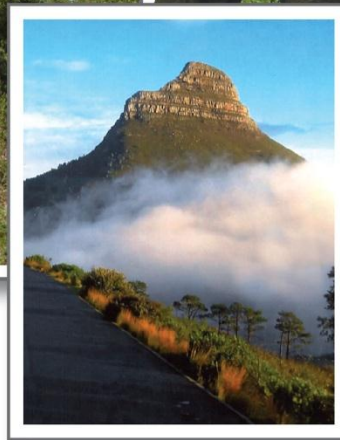

#### Day 7: Monday, September 24, 2012

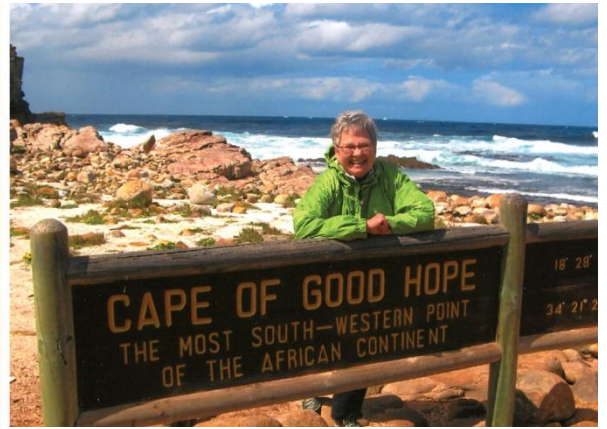
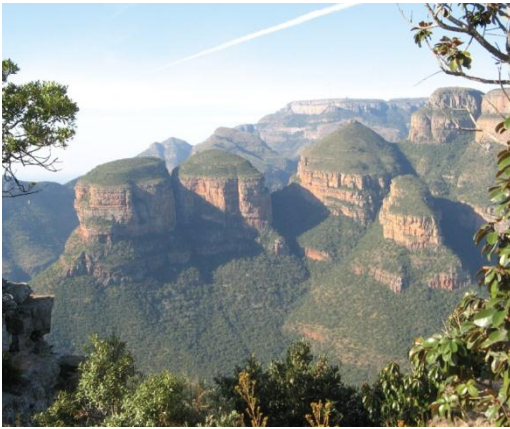
##### Kruger National Park - Safari Game Drive

Have your cameras ready for an unforgettable day of adventure and excitement! **Enjoy a full day open air vehicle safari game drive. A local expert leads you in search of the Big 5 - elephant, buffalo, lion, leopard and rhino - and provides insight into these fascinating animals along the way.** Watch carefully - you may also see a graceful impala, dazzling zebra or gorgeous giraffe. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*
